



### FOCUS ON FAMILY FUN

September is the \*perfect\* time to pick, taste, and cook with apples. This month, try an apple taste test with your children.

Choose 4 or 5 different types of apples: granny smith, honeycrisp, golden delicious, gala, red delicious, etc.

Cut the apples into slices & have everyone try each apple.

Discuss your taste test using strong adjectives. Which apple did you like the most? Which did you like the least? Which apple was the sweetest? The most sour?

Make predictions about which apple would be best for baking, to make applesauce, and to eat by itself.
